Letter from the Benefice Ministry Team

Just before I sat down to write this two contrasting items in the paper had caught my eye. The first item concerned the SNP politician Gillian Martin who had effectively lost her job in the Holyrood government before she started it because of the uncovering of unsavoury comments she'd posted on the Internet in 2007. The other item was about the ordination as a deacon in the Church of England of the former cabinet minister Jonathan Aitken who had served a prison sentence for perjury.

In this electronic age whatever ill considered, uninformed, intemperate things people (even you or I) may have launched into cyber space in the past can, like past remembered deeds, come back to haunt us but should they be allowed to forever hang as a dead weight around our necks? If we could never move on, never set aside past prejudice never learn from our mistakes the world would be a dark place indeed. If someone has said sorry and lived sorry then giving them a second chance gives us a chance as well; the chance that the world can become in some way a better place. It may be that those who have been in a dark place themselves are best equipped to help others out of a similar dark place.

Speaking in St Matthew's Westminster after his ordination Aitken said that when he first joined the congregation he was "trapped in a selfinflicted spiral of disasters which I have described as disgrace, defeat, divorce bankruptcy and jail. I was clinging by my fingertips to faith and occasionally to life itself. But the love and shared faith I found here helped to steer me through the encircling gloom". Aitken now proposes to devote his time to prison Chaplaincy.

God is nothing if not a realist; he knows that we have the capacity to make a tremendous mess of life, to get things wrong, to foul our own nest. At the same time one of the most tremendous attributes of God is that he actually does believe in us he believes that we can be wonderfully creative and caring, that we can leave the past behind and embrace a better future. That those who make the mess can be equipped to clear it up. The Churches in this Benefice stand as a testimony to the faith members of the communities in our parishes did have, do have in God. These Churches were raised up and continue to stand because people have grasped the fact that in the living, dying and rising of Jesus God came to raise us up and have believed that by saying yes to him they can embrace the creative living God wants for each of us.

To become a citizen of this country you have to pass a test; I would probably have failed the sample test I looked at miserably; I don't have a clue how long the Bayeux Tapestry is. With Jesus it's a bit simpler the only question is "Do you want to leave the past behind and embrace the future with me?"

The religious people of Jesus's day were distinctly sniffy about the company he kept because they couldn't see past what those people had been but fortunately he could see what they could become; may we have that same capacity.



NEWS FROM THE VILLAGES

Local Police Report

First may I thank everyone who called in about the visits from the cold calling door to door sellers last month. Both the Force and I received many complaints and it appears that several local residents were verbally abused by them when advised they did not wish to purchase anything from the door. I wish to reiterate how important it is to let us know when they are in our area and please ask that you continue to call. They have to have a Police Issued Pedlars Certificate and not a made up 'Hawkers' certificate which they produce which is not worth the paper it is written on – thank you.

In Upton Grey I am receiving reports of anti-social behaviour and suspected illegal drug related activity on the recreation field, I am aware that recently a black car was seen and a group of youths – one of whose name I have, 'disappeared' when a Police vehicle was in the area as the result of another incident. I have stepped up police patrols and these will continue, unmarked police vehicles will also be in the area along with plain clothes visits to the area. I ask anyone with any information to please call me direct and all calls will be treated in strictest confidence. Likewise if you see any suspicious activity please call. To those involved, it's a small village, I know who you are and I am building a file on you. I will do all in my power, with others, not to allow young people in the area to become involved in something that will ultimately result in a downward spiral of harm and to take action against those that are involved.

Slightly further afield but not that far in the Up Nately area we have experienced an increase in burglaries of sheds and outbuildings, including several in one night. This has resulted in the theft of thousands of pounds of chainsaws and other garden equipment. I continue to urge residents to photograph, mark and record details of their equipment, to use bolts on door hinges and locks and not screws which the criminals simply unscrew and take the door off. Please consider shed alarms and security lighting. The criminals are targeting an area and we may not be excluded.

Long Sutton Primary School - Foundation Governor vacancy

Because Long Sutton Primary School is a Church of England Voluntary Controlled school, one of its distinguishing features is a is the inclusion of Foundation Governors on the governing body. Though they represent the historic link with the original establishment of the school and its distinctive religious ethos, in most ways Foundation Governors are the same as other governors. All governors are entrusted with the responsibility for ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction; holding the Headteacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils and the performance-management of staff; and overseeing the financial performance of the school and making sure its money is well spent. In addition, as Governors of a Church of England Controlled school, we uphold and promote the ethos of the school which is firmly based on distinctively Christian values. Our Foundation Governors play a significant part in helping us to maintain our connection with the Diocese and ensuring the character and ethos of the school.

After several years of dedicated service, two of our three Foundation Governors are retiring from their role in the coming months and we are looking to replace them on our Governing Body of fifteen Governors. Though Foundation Governors are usually local churchgoers, it is not necessary be local, a churchgoer – or even a practising Christian. It is absolutely essential to support the Christian distinctiveness of the school, to support its aims and to have the time to prepare for and attend meetings, and to carry out other duties. The role carries the full governor responsibilities and excellent training is available from both the Diocese and Hampshire Governor Services.

This is an opportunity to join our purposeful and committed team of governors, ('skilled and ambitious', according to Ofsted, March 2018) working for the development of our school. If you are interested in joining us as a Foundation Governor, or just wish to explore what it means to be a school governor, please get in touch for a [no obligation] conversation about the role.

News from Long Sutton Church of England Primary School

We have come to the end of a wonderfully busy year at Long Sutton CE Primary School. Saving Water is important for everyone.

We will probably be sitting staring at the rain lashing down on our gardens by the time you get to read this! But just in case the record breaking warm and sunny weather holds here are some helpful tips from South East Water.

Learn to love your brown lawn. The brown grass will provide shade for the green grass underneath which will spring back once the rain returns. Water your plants after 9pm to avoid evaporation.

Take shorter showers. Don't wash the car, just keep your lights, mirrors and number plates clear.

As the heat increases, so does the amount of water we all use. To cope with this, South East Water is producing an extra 100 million litres a day across its supply area – the equivalent of 40 Olympic swimming pools of water.

High demand for water is often caused by garden watering – on a normal day it makes up six per cent of water use in the home, but on hot days this can soar to 70 per cent, mainly due to garden sprinklers which use as much water in an hour as a family of six uses in a day.

Some people may experience lower than normal pressures in high demand periods like breakfast and dinner time. Everyone is being asked to reduce garden water use during peak times to try to make sure there is enough water for everyone.

Being water savvy will help ease pressure on the company's extensive network of 9,000 miles of pipes, pumping stations and treatment works which are working at full pelt around the clock to keep taps running.

Despite the recent dry spell, reservoir and ground water levels are as expected for this time of year.
