A letter from the Benefice Rector

Dear Friends,

Jesus said "love your enemies..." but didn't say "don't have any."

The saying is often taken to imply that if we love our enemies they will in fact cease to be enemies and that a warm embrace and a softening of anger will cure all. I'm not so sure about that.

After all, cultivating an attitude of love towards someone does not mean that they will cease to oppose you (the word translated 'enemy' might be more helpfully interpreted 'opponent'), nor does it mean that deeply held differences of opinion will be reconciled and fade away.

What it does mean however is that the person with whom we disagree, or the individual who is opposing us, will not be vilified or depersonalised, but instead recognised as possessing the dignity of a shared humanity.

In a culture where Twitter debates (I use that term as loosely as possible) often rapidly descend into name-calling and anonymous outpourings of vitriol, and in a society which is trying to discuss and debate some of the most significant political, social and economic issues for a generation, the need for a love of 'opponent' that recognises the dignity of a shared humanity is more important than ever. Only in this way can the argument, debate and discussion be done well and in a way that leads to human flourishing.

And this is true within the church as much as in the wider world. Far too often the church fails to deal with disagreement well. Partly because many churches default to being a bit like an English dinner party set to an organ piece, where any controversial conversation is a no go and we try to make sure that politics and, oddly religion, aren't spoken of!

But taking seriously Jesus's command to love our opponents should mean that the church family is the best possible place to disagree, even strongly and passionately. A place where disagreement is conducted with grace and humility. A community in which genuine differences of opinion are no barrier to friendship and support.

John McDonnell recently said that he could never be friends with a Conservative. That's a shame for both the Conservative and for John, because it is so often in our disagreements that we learn something about ourselves as well as the other. It is often when faced by an opponent who we meet with love and grace, that we grow into a slightly better version of ourselves.

This Jesus, he was onto something you know...

NEWS FROM THE VILLAGES

Upton Grey Shop Break-ins

As many of you will know our Village Shop was broken into twice in November, and the Village Hall Committee are taking steps to ensure there is no third burglary.

The plan is to enhance the security of the shop in three stages: by reinforcing the doors and windows, by fitting CCTV, and by repositioning motion-sensitive lighting. The first of these improvements is in hand, and a steel shutter for the front door is due to be installed on Tuesday 11 December. The door and windows at the back of the shop have already been strengthened, and the windows at the front will be reinforced as soon as is practicable.

The committee will ask two security firms for their suggestions regarding cameras and lighting. We shall be investigating the possibility of obtaining grants.

Thanks to the considerable generosity of the village, donations totalling over $\pounds 1,000$ will cover the cost of the steel shutter (c. $\pounds 650$) and some of the other necessary alterations and improvements.

The Village Hall Committee are immensely grateful to all those who have contributed. It is enormously appreciated. If you would like to make a donation, please make cheques payable to Upton Grey Village Hall Committee and hand them either to Brian Thrussell (Wayside Cottage) or me (Spinners). Our houses are either side of the village hall.

There is one more thing you could do, and that is to use our wonderful shop a little more. Suki has taken a huge financial hit in the past few weeks, and you might wish to show your support by shopping local!

Local Police Report

Dear residents, First may I wish you all a very Happy New Year. In next month's edition I will provide residents with a breakdown of reported crime across the area of this magazine.

From 2018 I am seeking any assistance in relation to the following crimes. Overnight of November 26th 2018 a farm unit was broken into in Scratchface Lane, Herriard and a quad bike stolen. We have since recovered this machine, however the thieves broke in via the gate next to the former school on the A339 then cut across the field, but they don't seem to have left this way? If you saw or heard anything that night please give me a call.

On the same night two further farm units were broken into in the Dummer area, and a car was stolen from Axford - the thieves saw the car keys on a hall table. I continue to urge residents not to leave their car keys in the hall. Please put them away out of sight in another room or take them upstairs with you.

I am also seeking any further information in relation to the burglary of the Upton Grey shop back on November 30^{th} . We are aware that someone was seen in the shop at 8:50 pm that evening and a dark 4 x 4 and a white van were seen outside. Again, I ask if anyone was in the area and passed the shop about this time, if they recall anything in relation to the vehicles, or perhaps saw anyone. We know the village hall was not in use that evening.

During the New Year I am proposing to hold similar crime prevention evenings at some villages that did not host them in 2018, these are combined with help from Trading Standards and were well received by residents of whom 140 attended the three largest ones. If you can assist in anyway in relation to my crime information appeals, please give me a call direct, as always all calls treated in strictest confidence. Recipe of the month:

Penne with Leeks and Bacon (Delia Smith) Serves 4

350g penne or macaroni3 small leeks, cleaned and chopped175g streaky bacon, choppedOlive oil

50g butter For the sauce 50g butter 50g plain flour 850ml milk 175g Cheddar cheese 75ml double cream Freshly grated nutmeg Salt and pepper

Method

Bring a large saucepan of water to simmering point, add salt, a few drops of olive oil and the pasta. Bring back to the boil and cook for 10 mins.

Drain pasta in a colander.

While the pasta is cooking melt the butter, fry the bacon then add the chopped leeks to soften.

In another pan make the white sauce, season to taste, add a grating of nutmeg and the cream. Then turn the pasta, leeks, bacon and sauce into a dish and mix well. Sprinkle the top with Parmesan , breadcrumbs and cayenne pepper.

Put into pre heated oven gas mark 4, 180 C for 30-40 mins until the top is brown and the sauce bubbling.

Rough Sleeping in Basingstoke:

The information below was recently published by the Borough Council and republished in the December Tunworth Newsletter.

The number of rough sleepers in Basingstoke is 8, which is a reduction from 15 in 2017 and 26 in 2016. This is down to the joined up work of the Social Inclusion Partnership and the resources and focus given by the Council. As in previous years, the Social Inclusion Partnership (SIP) will launch the *Real Change not Loose Change* campaign

https://www.basingstoke.gov.uk/real-change at the start of December, as part of a wider package of measures to help rough sleepers and prevent homelessness. The campaign aims to raise awareness of how people can best help rough sleepers in the borough, providing information on how to let us know if there is someone sleeping on the streets, how to donate time or items to help local homelessness charities or groups and how to donate money as an alternative to giving direct. Over £40,000 has been raised over the last two years.

This year, the SIP has decided to build on its commitment to tackling homelessness by launching a year-round campaign.

First to benefit from any donations will be the Night Light Winter Night Shelter, which will open its doors again for three months on Saturday 1 December offering 15 bed spaces until February 2019. Night shelter guests will have access to rough sleeping support services, a clinical psychologist service and health check-ups, with a warm welcome and support from volunteers and local church members. When this total is achieved a new local homelessness fundraising project will be added to the fundraising platform being used, the Good Exchange. Individuals, groups or organisations can raise funds for the Real Change campaign, be it through a sponsored walk or cake sale, through the Good Exchange platform by linking to the campaign. Donation boxes will also be placed around the town centre and any other locations willing to take one.


