An essential farming community, Herriard has evolved from a group of small hamlets and farms in Saxon times, survived the effects of the black death, dissolution of the monasteries and civil war, to become the thriving village it is today. Over 35 businesses make Herriard their base, employing around 150 people and enriching our community.

## ST MARY'S CHURCH



Built around the year 1200, St Mary's remains a focal point of our village to this day. It has undergone a couple of renovations in its time; a renovation and new tower was built by Francis M E Jervoise in 1878, and the bells and bell tower were restored in 2008. The Parochial Church Council organise many events throughout the year, including a village fete and harvest festival supper, and hold a regular youth group.

## HERRIARD GREEN



Herriard Green is a great space for everyone in the community, featuring footpaths surrounded by meadows and a children's play area. The green is also home to Herriard Sports Club, a club that's been part of the community since 1884. After moving sites around the village over the years, the club now has permanent roots on the green. The Owen White Pavilion sits centre to the cricket, football and tennis facilities.
