Collaborative self and custom build

Embarking on a group self or custom build project is a great way to build a home and is one of the lowest cost routes. Group self-build typically saves 40% on plot costs and 10% on build costs.

A group self or custom build project can still give you the freedom to build a home that you want, whilst at the same time giving you the opportunity to work with others and build a community in the process.

Finding the right site for your home is not always easy but, group self-build can make site identification easier by purchasing a larger or trickier site with others.

There are a variety of collaborative self and custom build projects across the UK. We are really keen to start similar projects here in Basingstoke and Deane.

- Bristol Community Land Trust built their first self-build scheme at Fishponds Road back in 2016. This scheme provides affordable rent and discounted sale 'self-finish' homes for local people www.bristolclt.co.uk/fishponds-rd
- Lancaster Co-housing provided 41 zero carbon homes for leasehold sale to members
 of the co-housing group. The homes were designed by the group through a series of
 workshops with their chosen architect. Future sales will be at open market value.

- Bunker housing cooperative was started by two families on modest incomes wanting
 to 'help themselves' by building two family homes for affordable rent in Brighton.
 They are now expanding to provide more self-build homes at affordable rent for
 local families on modest incomes through the coop model.

- Petersfield Community Land Trust are working on a self-build project and want to provide serviced self-build plots at a discount market price, prioritised for local people. As part of the planning application there will be a design code for the scheme which will set out the design parameters for the self-build plots.
