Letter from the Benefice Ministry Team

I'm often struck by how there are some things in life which we just have to keep doing repeatedly.

I know in our household, it's often the laundry! We wash our clothes, we dry them, we fold them, and then after we've worn them, we do it all over again. Wash. Dry. Fold. Repeat. And unless you don't mind walking around in dirty clothes, it's a process we have to keep on doing. Wash. Dry. Fold. Repeat. Wash. Dry. Fold. Repeat.



Amongst the many things God teaches us to do in the Bible, is to consistently rejoice, pray, give thanks – and repeat.

We find this instruction in Paul's first letter to the early Christian church, in the bustling seaport of Thessalonica in Greece, in about AD 50. He tells the Christians there to do this:

'Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus' (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18)

We're going to be looking at the whole of this letter (1 Thessalonians) in all 12 churches across our benefice through the month of April, and as we get towards the end of the letter we receive this instruction.

The wonderful truth in this verse is that as Christians we **can** rejoice always, we **can** give thanks in all circumstances. Not because we just always 'feel happy' – sometimes in our lives we experience terrible suffering or sadness, and even on a week-by-week basis things don't always go as wonderfully as we'd hoped.

Instead, we can rejoice always because of what Jesus has done for us, which is a constant reality.

We've just remembered over Easter how he died for us on the cross, that all our sins might be forgiven as we turn to him and put our trust in him, so that we might know freedom in our lives – perfect freedom from fear and anxiety and additions and so much more.

But there's more! We also remembered how he rose again from the dead, at his resurrection three days later - conquering death, so that we might all live through him - not just now, but for eternity.



Jesus has enabled all this for us – all we have to do is turn to him, put our faith in him. And as we then follow him day-by-day throughout our lives, we have cause to rejoice always, to give thanks in all circumstances – because of what he's done.

So let's do that constantly this April – rejoice, pray, give thanks – and repeat!

Hi everyone!

As I drive around at the moment, I'm blown away by nature... All around me, plants that have been hidden by winter are bursting into life. Bulbs are blooming. Trees are full of blossom. You know, Jesus often used nature to tell us more about God and how God wants us to live, and as I drove around and started to get excited about strawberry picking, apple munching and blackberry jam making, I was reminded of how someone else in the Bible called Paul spoke about fruit – but a different sort of fruit: fruit of the spirit. Maybe you know a song all about them? Why don't you listen to a song about them by scanning this QR code.

So, this is how the story goes. A guy named Paul wrote a letter to a group of people who were trying to follow Jesus, but they weren't treating each other the way Jesus would have. They ended up getting into silly arguments, kicking people out of their group for no good reason and even losing faith in God. Paul reminded them to be more like Jesus, more like God, more like the Holy Spirit. He then went on to list nine fruit (or characteristics in their lives) that show that we are God's friends. He didn't mean people who follow Jesus should have grapes or pineapples growing from their elbows. Instead, Paul meant that as we grow in our faith, we become more and more like Jesus. Our lives will bear more good fruit.

This place Paul was writing to isn't the only place where people act like that, is it? Let's be honest, we can all make mistakes about how we act sometimes, can't we... But, Paul says that if we follow Jesus, what we do and how we act, becomes more like what Jesus would do.

Over the next few months I'll think about a different fruit of the spirit each time. In the meantime, sing along to the song and see if you can work out what the nine fruit are and think about whether your tree has enough of all these fruit on it!

NEWS FROM THE VILLAGES

Farming news

March has sprung upon us and it has brought more rain with it. Dad and I keep saying to ourselves 'it surely can't keep raining' in the hope that it may change. But we have managed to get out in the fields to apply the first dose of nitrogen fertiliser for the crops to give them a 'pick me up' after the long wet winter. They have done remarkably well considering how wet it has been and they are responding to the fertiliser nicely as the weather is generally mild, albeit wet. In the small weather window that we got in the first week of March, we managed to start planting some barley. We have picked out the lighter more chalky fields to drill first as these had dried out quicker and are less prone to water logging when it rains again, which, as I write this, it is raining. But the days are drawing out and the longer daylight hours will help to encourage growth and hopefully the freshly planted barley will be poking through the surface relatively quickly.

Our next job is to apply sulphur fertiliser to our crops, which we will do in the next break in weather. We have to apply sulphur to all our crops as there isn't enough surplus in the atmosphere for the crops to feed on. Historically with coal power stations being the only way of producing electricity, the burning of coal produced more than enough sulphur in the atmosphere that farmers didn't need to apply it in fertiliser form. Both sulphur and nitrogen are key fertilisers that aid plants in their process of photosynthesis. As the crops start to grow and the weather turns warmer/sunnier we will have to apply fungicides to the crops to help protect them from diseases and pests. With a generally warm winter these diseases will be at a higher risk as there hasn't been a great deal of prolonged cold weather to naturally kill these off.

Which brings me onto my experiment that I mentioned in my last article, where the plan was to graze half a field of wheat, the aim being that the older leaves that are carrying these diseases would be grazed off by the sheep and inevitable help reduce our pesticide use. Frustratingly, due to the wet weather I decided to go against this, mainly because the sheep would have done more damage than good, so it wasn't a viable option. I won't give up though and will attempt this again next year.

We also have successfully passed our 'Red Tractor' audit for another year, which means that the combinable crops we grow can be used as ingredients to make products that bear the red tractor logo.

So we will cross our fingers for a turn in the weather to allow us to tend to the crops in good time and to be able to walk the dogs without them getting filthy!

Why do toads cross roads?

During breeding season frogs and toads naturally try to migrate back to the bodies of water where they originally spawned so they can mate and lay eggs. Unfortunately, manmade structures like roads and fences can provide difficult obstacles for wildlife to cross over, especially as they grow into larger adults and are unable to slip back through the holes they first came through. It is estimated that a staggering 20 tonnes of toads are killed on UK roads every year.

During February, Hampshire & Isle of Wight Wildlife Trust rescued 170 toads and 7 frogs, thanks to the efforts of the Swanwick Lakes Education and Engagement team.

The team carefully collected and counted the toads and frogs, including mating pairs, from along a security fence line. They were then safely released onto the other side of the fence to continue their migration to their breeding grounds, and so are now able to spawn the next generation.

Frogs are both predators and prey, which makes them an important part of the food chain. They provide a vital source of food for several species, as well as helping to control populations of others. They are also considered an indicator species as they are very sensitive to changes in their environment (both aquatic and terrestrial) and their permeable skin makes them especially vulnerable to pollutants. Monitoring populations of indicator species can be an important way to pick up on early warning signs of environmental changes or damage to natural habitats and ecosystems.

There are only four native species of frog in the UK of which two are toads. Toads are a type of frog but they have shorter legs, broader noses and drier (and bumpier) skin, which allows them to survive for longer in dry conditions compared to most other frogs. Toads also produce bufotoxin via their skin to defend themselves from predators. Unfortunately, toad populations in the UK have been steadily declining due to habitat loss, pollution and climate change. Because of this they are listed as a biodiversity priority species under the Natural Environment and Rural Communities (NERC) Act (2006).

Swanwick Lakes Nature Reserve is owned by NATS (national air traffic control services) and managed in partnership with Hampshire & Isle of Wight Wildlife Trust. Several amphibians call the reserve home, including three species of newt. They provide a vital source of food for

other wildlife including herons, grass snakes and badgers, plus dragonflies and damselflies.
